

The Word “Power” as found in the New Testament of the King James Version of the Holy Bible

There are 168 occurrences of the word “power”, or a derivative, found in the New Testament, translated from 10 different Greek words.

Archē, Greek Strong's #746, is a noun found 58 times, translated as beginning (40), principality (8), corner (2), first (2), *miscellaneous translations* (6). It is translated as “power” in the following verse:

Luke 20:20 –

And they watched *him*, and sent forth spies, which should feign themselves just men, that they might take hold of his words, that so they might deliver him unto the power and authority of the governor.

Didōmi, Greek Strong's #1325, is a verb found 413 times, translated as give (365), grant (10), put (5), show (4), deliver (2), make (2), *miscellaneous translations* (25). It is translated as “power” in the following verses:

Revelation 6:4 –

And there went out another horse *that was* red: and power was given to him that sat thereon to take peace from the earth, and that they should kill one another: and there was given unto him a great sword.

Revelation 13:14 –

And deceiveth them that dwell on the earth by *the means of* those miracles which he had power to do in the sight of the beast; saying to them that dwell on the earth, that they should make an image to the beast, which had the wound by a sword, and did live.

Revelation 13:15 –

And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed.

Dynamai, Greek Strong's #1410, is a verb found 210 times, translated as can (could) (100), cannot + <G3756> (45), be able (37), may (might) (18), able (3), *miscellaneous translations* (7). It is translated as “power” in the following verse:

Romans 16:25 –

Now to him that is of power to stablish you according to my gospel, and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery, which was kept secret since the world began,

Dynamis, Greek Strong's #1411, is a noun found 120 times, translated as power (77), mighty work (11), strength (7), miracle (7), might (4), virtue (3), mighty (2), *miscellaneous translations* (9). It is translated as "power" in the following verses:

Matthew 6:13 –

And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.

Matthew 22:29 –

Jesus answered and said unto them, Ye do err, not knowing the scriptures, nor the power of God.

Matthew 24:29 –

Immediately after the tribulation of those days shall the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken:

Matthew 24:30 –

And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.

Matthew 26:64 –

Jesus saith unto him, Thou hast said: nevertheless I say unto you, Hereafter shall ye see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.

Mark 9:1 –

And he said unto them, Verily I say unto you, That there be some of them that stand here, which shall not taste of death, till they have seen the kingdom of God come with power.

Mark 12:24 –

And Jesus answering said unto them, Do ye not therefore err, because ye know not the scriptures, neither the power of God?

Mark 13:25 –

And the stars of heaven shall fall, and the powers that are in heaven shall be shaken.

Mark 13:26 –

And then shall they see the Son of man coming in the clouds with great power and glory.

Mark 14:62 –

And Jesus said, I am: and ye shall see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.

Luke 1:17 –

And he shall go before him in the spirit and power of Elias, to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just; to make ready a people prepared for the Lord.

Luke 1:35 –

And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God.

Luke 4:14 –

And Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit into Galilee: and there went out a fame of him through all the region round about.

Luke 4:36 –

And they were all amazed, and spake among themselves, saying, What a word *is* this! for with authority and power he commandeth the unclean spirits, and they come out.

Luke 5:17 –

And it came to pass on a certain day, as he was teaching, that there were Pharisees and doctors of the law sitting by, which were come out of every town of Galilee, and Judaea, and Jerusalem: and the power of the Lord was *present* to heal them.

Luke 9:1 –

Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases.

Luke 10:19 –

Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Luke 21:26 –

Men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth: for the powers of heaven shall be shaken.

Luke 21:27 –

And then shall they see the Son of man coming in a cloud with power and great glory.

Luke 22:69 –

Hereafter shall the Son of man sit on the right hand of the power of God.

Luke 24:49 –

And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.

Acts 1:8 –

But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

Acts 3:12 –

And when Peter saw *it*, he answered unto the people, Ye men of Israel, why marvel ye at this? or why look ye so earnestly on us, as though by our own power or holiness we had made this man to walk?

Acts 4:7 –

And when they had set them in the midst, they asked, By what power, or by what name, have ye done this?

Acts 4:33 –

And with great power gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all.

Acts 6:8 –

And Stephen, full of faith and power, did great wonders and miracles among the people.

Acts 8:10 –

To whom they all gave heed, from the least to the greatest, saying, This man is the great power of God.

Acts 10:38 –

How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

Romans 1:4 –

And declared *to be* the Son of God with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead:

Romans 1:16 –

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

Romans 1:20 –

For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, *even* his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse:

Romans 8:38 –

For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come,

Romans 9:17 –

For the scripture saith unto Pharaoh, Even for this same purpose have I raised thee up, that I might shew my power in thee, and that my name might be declared throughout all the earth.

Romans 15:13 –

Now the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that ye may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Ghost.

Romans 15:19 –

Through mighty signs and wonders, by the power of the Spirit of God; so that from Jerusalem, and round about unto Illyricum, I have fully preached the gospel of Christ.

1 Corinthians 1:18 –

For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God.

1 Corinthians 1:24 –

But unto them which are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God, and the wisdom of God.

1 Corinthians 2:4 –

And my speech and my preaching *was* not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power:

1 Corinthians 2:5 –

That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.

1 Corinthians 4:19 –

But I will come to you shortly, if the Lord will, and will know, not the speech of them which are puffed up, but the power.

1 Corinthians 4:20 –

For the kingdom of God *is* not in word, but in power.

1 Corinthians 5:4 –

In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, when ye are gathered together, and my spirit, with the power of our Lord Jesus Christ,

1 Corinthians 6:14 –

And God hath both raised up the Lord, and will also raise up us by his own power.

1 Corinthians 15:24 –

Then *cometh* the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to God, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power.

1 Corinthians 15:43 –

It is sown in dishonour; it is raised in glory: it is sown in weakness; it is raised in power:

2 Corinthians 4:7 –

But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellency of the power may be of God, and not of us.

2 Corinthians 6:7 –

By the word of truth, by the power of God, by the armour of righteousness on the right hand and on the left,

2 Corinthians 8:3 –

For to *their* power, I bear record, yea, and beyond *their* power *they were* willing of themselves;

2 Corinthians 12:9 –

And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

2 Corinthians 13:4 –

For though he was crucified through weakness, yet he liveth by the power of God. For we also are weak in him, but we shall live with him by the power of God toward you.

Ephesians 1:19 –

And what *is* the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power,

Ephesians 3:7 –

Whereof I was made a minister, according to the gift of the grace of God given unto me by the effectual working of his power.

Ephesians 3:20 –

Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us,

Philippians 3:10 –

That I may know him, and the power of his resurrection, and the fellowship of his sufferings, being made conformable unto his death;

1 Thessalonians 1:5 –

For our gospel came not unto you in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Ghost, and in much assurance; as ye know what manner of men we were among you for your sake.

2 Thessalonians 1:11 –

Wherefore also we pray always for you, that our God would count you worthy of *this* calling, and fulfil all the good pleasure of *his* goodness, and the work of faith with power:

2 Thessalonians 2:9 –

Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders,

2 Timothy 1:7 –

For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

2 Timothy 1:8 –

Be not thou therefore ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me his prisoner: but be thou partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God;

2 Timothy 3:5 –

Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.

Hebrews 1:3 –

Who being the brightness of *his* glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;

Hebrews 6:5 –

And have tasted the good word of God, and the powers of the world to come,

Hebrews 7:16 –

Who is made, not after the law of a carnal commandment, but after the power of an endless life.

1 Peter 1:5 –

Who are kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

1 Peter 3:22 –

Who is gone into heaven, and is on the right hand of God; angels and authorities and powers being made subject unto him.

2 Peter 1:3 –

According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that *pertain* unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:

2 Peter 1:16 –

For we have not followed cunningly devised fables, when we made known unto you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were eyewitnesses of his majesty.

Revelation 4:11 –

Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.

Revelation 5:12 –

Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing.

Revelation 7:12 –

Saying, Amen: Blessing, and glory, and wisdom, and thanksgiving, and honour, and power, and might, *be* unto our God for ever and ever. Amen.

Revelation 11:17 –

Saying, We give thee thanks, O Lord God Almighty, which art, and wast, and art to come; because thou hast taken to thee thy great power, and hast reigned.

Revelation 13:2 –

And the beast which I saw was like unto a leopard, and his feet were as *the feet* of a bear, and his mouth as the mouth of a lion: and the dragon gave him his power, and his seat, and great authority.

Revelation 15:8 –

And the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God, and from his power; and no man was able to enter into the temple, till the seven plagues of the seven angels were fulfilled.

Revelation 16:8 –

And the fourth angel poured out his vial upon the sun; and power was given unto him to scorch men with fire.

Revelation 17:13 –

These have one mind, and shall give their power and strength unto the beast

Revelation 19:1 –

And after these things I heard a great voice of much people in heaven, saying, Alleluia; Salvation, and glory, and honour, and power, unto the Lord our God:

Dynatos, Greek Strong's #1415, is an adjective found 35 times, translated as possible (13), able (10), mighty (6), strong (3), could (1), power (1), mighty man (1). It is translated as “power” in the following verse:

Romans 9:22 –

What if God, willing to shew *his* wrath, and to make his power known, endured with much longsuffering the vessels of wrath fitted to destruction:

Exousia, Greek Strong's #1849, is a noun found 103 times, translated as power (69), authority (29), right (2), liberty (1), jurisdiction (1), strength (1). It is translated as “power” in the following verses:

Matthew 9:6 –

But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power on earth to forgive sins, (then saith he to the sick of the palsy,) Arise, take up thy bed, and go unto thine house.

Matthew 9:8 –

But when the multitudes saw *it*, they marvelled, and glorified God, which had given such power unto men.

Matthew 10:1 –

And when he had called unto *him* his twelve disciples, he gave them power *against* unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all manner of sickness and all manner of disease.

Matthew 28:18 –

And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

Mark 2:10 –

But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power on earth to forgive sins, (he saith to the sick of the palsy,)

Mark 3:15 –

And to have power to heal sicknesses, and to cast out devils:

Mark 6:7 –

And he called *unto him* the twelve, and began to send them forth by two and two; and gave them power over unclean spirits;

Luke 4:6 –

And the devil said unto him, All this power will I give thee, and the glory of them: for that is delivered unto me; and to whomsoever I will I give it.

Luke 4:32 –

And they were astonished at his doctrine: for his word was with power.

Luke 5:24 –

But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power upon earth to forgive sins, (he said unto the sick of the palsy,) I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy couch, and go into thine house.

Luke 10:19 –

Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Luke 12:5 –

But I will forewarn you whom ye shall fear: Fear him, which after he hath killed hath power to cast into hell; yea, I say unto you, Fear him.

Luke 12:11 –

And when they bring you unto the synagogues, and *unto* magistrates, and powers, take ye no thought how or what thing ye shall answer, or what ye shall say:

Luke 22:53 –

When I was daily with you in the temple, ye stretched forth no hands against me: but this is your hour, and the power of darkness.

John 10:18 –

No man taketh it from me, but I lay it down of myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This commandment have I received of my Father.

John 17:2 –

As thou hast given him power over all flesh, that he should give eternal life to as many as thou hast given him.

John 19:10 –

Then saith Pilate unto him, Speakest thou not unto me? knowest thou not that I have power to crucify thee, and have power to release thee?

John 19:11 –

Jesus answered, Thou couldest have no power at all against me, except it were given thee from above: therefore he that delivered me unto thee hath the greater sin.

Acts 1:7 –

And he said unto them, It is not for you to know the times or the seasons, which the Father hath put in his own power.

John 1:12 –

But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, *even* to them that believe on his name:

Acts 5:4 –

Whiles it remained, was it not thine own? and after it was sold, was it not in thine own power? why hast thou conceived this thing in thine heart? thou hast not lied unto men, but unto God.

Acts 8:19 –

Saying, Give me also this power, that on whomsoever I lay hands, he may receive the Holy Ghost.

Acts 26:18 –

To open their eyes, *and* to turn *them* from darkness to light, and *from* the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.

Romans 9:21 –

Hath not the potter power over the clay, of the same lump to make one vessel unto honour, and another unto dishonour?

Romans 13:1 –

Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God.

Romans 13:2 –

Whosoever therefore resisteth the power, resisteth the ordinance of God: and they that resist shall receive to themselves damnation.

Romans 13:3 –

For rulers are not a terror to good works, but to the evil. Wilt thou then not be afraid of the power? do that which is good, and thou shalt have praise of the same:

1 Corinthians 7:37 –

Nevertheless he that standeth stedfast in his heart, having no necessity, but hath power over his own will, and hath so decreed in his heart that he will keep his virgin, doeth well.

1 Corinthians 9:4 –

Have we not power to eat and to drink?

1 Corinthians 9:5 –

Have we not power to lead about a sister, a wife, as well as other apostles, and *as* the brethren of the Lord, and Cephas?

1 Corinthians 9:6 –

Or I only and Barnabas, have not we power to forbear working?

1 Corinthians 9:12 –

If others be partakers of *this* power over you, *are* not we rather? Nevertheless we have not used this power; but suffer all things, lest we should hinder the gospel of Christ.

1 Corinthians 9:18 –

What is my reward then? *Verily* that, when I preach the gospel, I may make the gospel of Christ without charge, that I abuse not my power in the gospel.

1 Corinthians 11:10 –

For this cause ought the woman to have power on *her* head because of the angels.

2 Corinthians 13:10 –

Therefore I write these things being absent, lest being present I should use sharpness, according to the power which the Lord hath given me to edification, and not to destruction.

Ephesians 1:21 –

Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come:

Ephesians 2:2 –

Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience:

Ephesians 3:10 –

To the intent that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly *places* might be known by the church the manifold wisdom of God,

Ephesians 6:12 –

For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.

Colossians 1:13 –

Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated *us* into the kingdom of his dear Son:

Colossians 1:16 –

For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether *they be* thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him:

Colossians 2:10 –

And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power:

Colossians 2:15 –

And having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it.

Luke 9:43 –

And they were all amazed at the mighty power of God. But while they wondered every one at all things which Jesus did, he said unto his disciples,

2 Thessalonians 3:9 –

Not because we have not power, but to make ourselves an ensample unto you to follow us.

Titus 3:1 –

Put them in mind to be subject to principalities and powers, to obey magistrates, to be ready to every good work,

Jude 1:25 –

To the only wise God our Saviour, *be* glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen.

Revelation 2:26 –

And he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations:

Revelation 6:8 –

And I looked, and behold a pale horse: and his name that sat on him was Death, and Hell followed with him. And power was given unto them over the fourth part of the earth, to kill with sword, and with hunger, and with death, and with the beasts of the earth.

Revelation 9:3 –

And there came out of the smoke locusts upon the earth: and unto them was given power, as the scorpions of the earth have power.

Revelation 9:10 –

And they had tails like unto scorpions, and there were stings in their tails: and their power was to hurt men five months.

Revelation 9:19 –

For their power is in their mouth, and in their tails: for their tails *were* like unto serpents, and had heads, and with them they do hurt.

Revelation 11:3 –

And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred *and* threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

Revelation 11:6 –

These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.

Revelation 12:10 –

And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.

Revelation 13:4 –

And they worshipped the dragon which gave power unto the beast: and they worshipped the beast, saying, Who *is* like unto the beast? who is able to make war with him?

Revelation 13:5 –

And there was given unto him a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies; and power was given unto him to continue forty *and* two months.

Revelation 13:7 –

And it was given unto him to make war with the saints, and to overcome them: and power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations.

Revelation 13:12 –

And he exerciseth all the power of the first beast before him, and causeth the earth and them which dwell therein to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed.

Revelation 14:18 –

And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe.

Revelation 16:9 –

And men were scorched with great heat, and blasphemed the name of God, which hath power over these plagues: and they repented not to give him glory.

Revelation 17:12 –

And the ten horns which thou sawest are ten kings, which have received no kingdom as yet; but receive power as kings one hour with the beast.

Revelation 18:1 –

And after these things I saw another angel come down from heaven, having great power; and the earth was lightened with his glory.

Revelation 20:6 –

Blessed and holy *is* he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years.

Exousiazō, Greek Strong's #1850, is a verb found 4 times, translated as have power of (2), exercise authority upon (1), bring under power (1). It is translated with “power” in the following verses:

1 Corinthians 6:12 –

All things are lawful unto me, but all things are not expedient: all things are lawful for me, but I will not be brought under the power of any.

1 Corinthians 7:4 –

The wife hath not power of her own body, but the husband: and likewise also the husband hath not power of his own body, but the wife.

Ischyros, Greek Strong's #2478, is an adjective found 27 times, translated as mighty (10), strong (9), strong man (5), boisterous (1), powerful (1), valiant (1). It is translated as “powerful” in the following verse:

2 Corinthians 10:10 –

For *his* letters, say they, *are* weighty and powerful; but *his* bodily presence *is* weak, and *his* speech contemptible.

Ischys, Greek Strong's #2479, is a noun found 11 times, translated as strength (4), power (2), might (2), ability (1), mightily + <G1722> (1), mighty (1). It is translated as “power” in the following verses:

2 Thessalonians 1:9 –

Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power;

2 Peter 2:11 –

Whereas angels, which are greater in power and might, bring not railing accusation against them before the Lord.

Kratos, Greek Strong's #2904, is a noun found 12 times, translated as power (6), dominion (4), strength (1), mighty + [G2596](#) (1). It is translated as “power” in the following verses:

Ephesians 6:10 –

Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.

Colossians 1:11 –

Strengthened with all might, according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness;

1 Timothy 6:16 –

Who only hath immortality, dwelling in the light which no man can approach unto; whom no man hath seen, nor can see: to whom *be* honour and power everlasting. Amen.

Hebrews 2:14 –

Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil;

Revelation 5:13 –

And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, *be* unto him that sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever.
