

**The Word “Create” as found in the New Testament
of the King James Version of the Holy Bible**

There are 35 occurrences of the word “create” (-ed), (-or), (-ion), (-ure) found in the New Testament.

Ktizo, Greek Strong's #2936, is a verb found 14 times, translated as create (12), Creator (1), make (1). It is translated as create (-or) in the following verses:

Mark 13:19 –

For *in* those days shall be affliction, such as was not from the beginning of the creation which God created unto this time, neither shall be.

Romans 1:25 –

Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen.

1 Corinthians 11:9 –

Neither was the man created for the woman; but the woman for the man.

Ephesians 2:10 –

For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

Ephesians 3:9 –

And to make all *men* see what *is* the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ:

Ephesians 4:24 –

And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.

Colossians 1:16 –

For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether *they be* thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him:

Colossians 3:10 –

And have put on the new *man*, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him:

1 Timothy 4:3 –

Forbidding to marry, *and commanding* to abstain from meats, which God hath created to be received with thanksgiving of them which believe and know the truth.

Revelation 4:11 –

Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.

Revelation 10:6 –

And swore by him that liveth for ever and ever, who created heaven, and the things that therein are, and the earth, and the things that therein are, and the sea, and the things which are therein, that there should be time no longer:

Ktisis, Greek Strong's #2937, is a noun found 19 times, translated as creature (11), creation (6), building (1), ordinance (1). It is translated as creat (-ure) (-ion) in the following verses:

Mark 10:6 –

But from the beginning of the creation God made them male and female.

Mark 13:19 –

For *in* those days shall be affliction, such as was not from the beginning of the creation which God created unto this time, neither shall be.

Mark 16:15 –

And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.

Romans 1:20 –

For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, *even* his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse:

Romans 1:25 –

Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen.

Romans 8:19 – 22 –

For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation of the sons of God. For the creature was made subject to vanity, not willingly, but by reason of him who hath subjected *the same* in hope, Because the creature itself also shall be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God. For we know that the whole creation groaneth and travaileth in pain together until now.

Romans 8:39 –

Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

2 Corinthians 5:17 –

Therefore if any man *be* in Christ, *he is* a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

Galatians 6:15 –

For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision, but a new creature.

Colossians 1:15 –

Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature:

Colossians 1:23 –

If ye continue in the faith grounded and settled, and *be* not moved away from the hope of the gospel, which ye have heard, *and* which was preached to every creature which is under heaven; whereof I Paul am made a minister;

Hebrews 4:13 –

Neither is there any creature that is not manifest in his sight: but all things *are* naked and opened unto the eyes of him with whom we have to do.

2 Peter 3:4 –

And saying, Where is the promise of his coming? for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as *they were* from the beginning of the creation.

Revelation 3:14 –

And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God;

Ktisma, Greek Strong's #2938, is a noun found 4 times, translated as “creature” in the following verses:

1 Timothy 4:4 –

For every creature of God *is* good, and nothing to be refused, if it be received with thanksgiving:

James 1:18 –

Of his own will begat he us with the word of truth, that we should be a kind of firstfruits of his creatures.

Revelation 5:13 –

And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, *be* unto him that sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever.

Revelation 8:9 –

And the third part of the creatures which were in the sea, and had life, died; and the third part of the ships were destroyed.

Ktistēs, Greek Strong's #2939, is a noun found 1 time, translated as “Creator” in the following verse:

1 Peter 4:19 –

Wherefore let them that suffer according to the will of God commit the keeping of their souls *to him* in well doing, as unto a faithful Creator.
