"Zion" and "Sion" as found in the New Testament of the King James Version of the Holy Bible

Σιών, Greek Strong's #4622, is translated as "Sion" 7 times in the NT, as follows:

Matthew 21:5 - Tell ye the daughter of <u>Sion</u>, Behold, thy King cometh unto thee, meek, and sitting upon an ass, and a colt the foal of an ass.

John 12:15 - Fear not, daughter of <u>Sion</u>: behold, thy King cometh, sitting on an ass's colt.

Romans 9:33 - As it is written, Behold, I lay in <u>Sion</u> a stumblingstone and rock of offence: and whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.

Romans 11:26 - And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, There shall come out of <u>Sion</u> the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob:

Hebrews 12:22 - But ye are come unto mount <u>Sion</u>, and unto the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to an innumerable company of angels,

1 Peter 2:6 - Wherefore also it is contained in the scripture, Behold, I lay in <u>Sion</u> a chief corner stone, elect, precious: and he that believeth on him shall not be confounded.

Revelation 14:1 - And I looked, and, lo, a Lamb stood on the mount <u>Sion</u>, and with him an hundred forty *and* four thousand, having his Father's name written in their foreheads.
