

## **“Zion” and “Sion” as found in the New Testament of the King James Version of the Holy Bible**

**Σιών**, Greek Strong's #4622, is translated as “Sion” 7 times in the NT, as follows:

**Matthew 21:5** - Tell ye the daughter of Sion, Behold, thy King cometh unto thee, meek, and sitting upon an ass, and a colt the foal of an ass.

**John 12:15** - Fear not, daughter of Sion: behold, thy King cometh, sitting on an ass's colt.

**Romans 9:33** - As it is written, Behold, I lay in Sion a stumblingstone and rock of offence: and whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.

**Romans 11:26** - And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, There shall come out of Sion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob:

**Hebrews 12:22** - But ye are come unto mount Sion, and unto the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to an innumerable company of angels,

**1 Peter 2:6** - Wherefore also it is contained in the scripture, Behold, I lay in Sion a chief corner stone, elect, precious: and he that believeth on him shall not be confounded.

**Revelation 14:1** - And I looked, and, lo, a Lamb stood on the mount Sion, and with him an hundred forty *and* four thousand, having his Father's name written in their foreheads.
